

Ziemke Lists Ross Scoring, Shows Miller With Several New Marks

Coach Al Ziemke of Ross high's cagers today produced some facts and figures on his squad's scoring proficiency during the season which ended at Sandusky last Thursday night when the Blue Streaks upset the Little Giants in the district A tourney.

Larry Miller, senior center, set a season's scoring record, getting 385 points against 367 tallied by Dick Garcia two

years ago. That was for all games played. In regular play independent of tournaments, Miller passed the 335 mark of John Lewis with a 342 total.

Last year Miller, son of H. Randall Miller, assistant principal of the high school, set a tournament game scoring record of 31, topping Garcia's mark of 25. Garcia is now playing basketball at Wooster College.
