## Ross wins GBC

Fremont Ross won its first Greater Buckeye Conference title with a 57-46 victory over Findlay on Friday.

Little Giants coach Mark Gedeon said the game was a squeaker until the last 2 minutes, 30 seconds.

"It was nip and tuck throughout," he said. "It was tied at the end of the first quarter, at the end of the second quarter at the end of the third quarter."

With Ross leading, Traveyon Wolverton drove to the basket and drew a foul. The Findlay player, who fouled out, also drew a technical on the play. Wolverton, who finished with eight points, made all four of his free throws, and then Cory Clayton, who finished with nine points, made four more free throws.

The GBC title was also the first one in the league's three-year history not won by Lima Senior. The Spartans handed Ross its only conference loss. The Little Giants finish the season 15-5 (9-1).

"We had an opportunity to take care of our own destiny and we did," Gedeon said.
